Tacoma, Wash. (Aug. 8, 2022) – For the first time in the past few years, **LeMay – America's Car Museum** is once again hosting its popular **Cruise-In** events. The first one is **Thursday**, **Aug. 11 from 5-7 pm PDT**, on the Haub Family Field.

This free, family-friendly event welcomes folks to bring their collector cars, trucks, and motorcycles for an evening of socializing and sharing car stories. All makes and models are welcome, and no registration is required. Car and motorcycle clubs are encouraged to show up and park together. The event will feature an emcee, music, food vendors on-site, and special Members Lane parking for active members of America's Car Museum and America's Automotive Trust. Also coming back, is the People's Choice Award with prizes including a Family Membership valued at \$120, and 10-year anniversary limited-edition products from the ACM Museum Store for first-, second-, and third-place winners.

The next Cruise-In will be **Sept. 6, 4-7 pm PDT**, and it will also be a special kickoff for AAT's **The Drive Home** – which is a convoy of collector and specialty cars driving from Tacoma, Wash. to Detroit, Mich. with stops along the way, culminating its arrival at the **North American International Detroit Auto Show** and **Detroit Concours d'Elegance**.
